1. Introduction

The parish is a Data Controller and is committed to protecting and respecting your privacy. This policy (together with any other documents referred to on it) sets out the basis on which any personal data we collect from you, or that you provide to us, will be processed by us. Please read the following carefully to understand our practices regarding your personal data and how we will treat it.

2. Your privacy matters to us

We will be open and transparent about any personal data that we collect about you via our website and other web services we offer. Who we are:

- We are located at St John the Baptist Church, Drumcondra, and North Strand Church, North Strand

3. We may process your personal data:

- to respond to a query, you might have sent us

- to remember your viewing preferences
- to manage access to our website

Processing your personal data is necessary to meet our legitimate interests in promoting our services and providing you with necessary information. We will request and obtain your consent to collect personal data such as your name and email address. We will retain this personal data in accordance with legislative requirements and in line with our data retention.

4. Transfers of data outside the European Economic Area

We do not transfer any personal data outside the European Economic Area.

5. Your rights relating to your personal data


You have the following rights, subject to certain exemptions, in relation to your personal data:

- right to access the data
- right to rectification
- right to erasure
- right to restriction of processing or to object to processing
- right to data portability

If we are processing personal data based on your consent, you may withdraw that consent at any time.

6. Requirement to process personal data

You may browse our website without providing us with any personal data and this will not affect your ability to view our website. However, if you do not provide us with your personal

You are free to decline our cookies, if your browser permits, or to ask your browser to indicate when a cookie is being sent. You can also delete cookie files from your computer if you wish to.
